






Do we accept these huge variations in quality and costs in healthcare?

Colorectal cancer care performance across multiple Dutch hospitals



Risk-adjusted hospital severe complication





- Provide disease expertise




Which role can pharma play in VBHC?




VBHC readiness differs greatly per country: The Netherlands is one of the frontrunners

How to get there ... Main take aways from 11th May Porter Congress

National level

Stimulate data exchange & transparency by improved IT infrastructure & privacy rules

\ Healthcare insurer

Move to quality contracts based on bundled payments, disease based not population

\ Healthcare provider

Apply existing outcome standards, don't re-invent the wheel









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
